Dear Choristers and Parents;

Welcome Back! I hope that you are ready to begin yet another exciting year of your all-too-fleeting high school experience. To facilitate this, there are several things that need to be taken care of in the beginning to avoid any misunderstandings throughout the course of the year. It is imperative that we have all policies and procedures clarified at this time in order to continue the success of our choral program. Your responsibilities will be as follows:

The John Carroll Choirs will again wear the Green Robes with the differentiated stoles. Under these robes, please wear BLACK PANTS, BLACK DRESS SHOES, BLACK SOCKS/STOCKINGS and your WHITE "Choir Robe T"SHIRT. Last year's shirt will do just fine! Nothing else, please!

1) PERFORMANCES AND REHEARSALS:

FALL CONCERT:

Thursday, October 14th at 7:00pm at Bruno Auditorium, John Carroll Catholic High School

7:00 AM MORNING REHEARSALS; at most three (3)

WINTER CONCERT:

Thursday, December 9th at 7:00pm at TBA

Dress Rehearsal on Monday, December 6th from 4:00 - 6:00 at TBA

7:00 AM MORNING REHEARSALS; at most three (3)

HOMECOMING CONCERT:

Sunday, May 15th at 5:00pm at Bruno Auditorium, John Carroll Catholic High School

7:00 AM FULL REHEARSALS; at most three (3)

AUDITIONS for the 2011-2012 choirs will take place in April and May 2011

2) **GRADING:**

50% **In Class:** Rehearsal Etiquette, Sight-Reading, etc.

20% **Class work:** Quizzes, Papers, etc. (Remember, this class is for honors credit!)

30% **Performances:** Morning Rehearsals, Dress Rehearsals, and Concerts

Please remember that while being a good singer is important, it is equally important that we develop good work and study habits, as well as sight-reading skills.

At some point in the spring the Honors Chorus will travel to a national contest. This trip will be a four-day, three-night engagement. Although attendance on this trip is not mandatory, we would love to have 100% participation. We need every member of the choir to be at our best. You will receive more information about this by the end of September.

Please be very much aware that YOU are the leaders of our choral program at John Carroll. It is expected that your behavior and attitudes reflect the seriousness of this. No one enjoys a good time more than I. However, there is a certain JOY that is attainable only through diligent self-discipline and accomplishment. This is our goal!

In accepting your position in this ensemble, you are acknowledging and accepting your responsibilities regarding your musical, professional and personal standards that you set for yourselves as well as others.
