

DANCES AND SOCIAL FUNCTIONS

Dances provide excellent social opportunities for John Carroll students.

- a. All school regulations must be observed.
- b. Only John Carroll students and their approved dates are permitted to attend dances.
- c. Students must remain in the Commons and other areas designated for the dance until they are ready to leave for the evening.
- d. Dances sponsored by John Carroll officially end at 11:00 p.m. Students should make arrangements to be picked up no later than 11:00 p.m.
- e. Students leaving a school-sponsored dance before the designated end will be required to sign out before leaving.

John Carroll School Dance Regulations

Ladies

- The bosom—the side and front must be covered
- The thighs—the length of the gown can be no more than one inch above the knee
- The midriff—no sheer or see-through material can be used and no skin may show
- The back—from the natural waist down
- **No strapless dresses are allowed**

Men

- Men must wear a tuxedo (prom) or dark sport coat, dress pants, with a tie (Homecoming & Q of H)
- Men must wear dress shoes with their tuxedo or suit
- Men must meet the grooming standards set forth in the John Carroll handbook.

Students who are bring an escort or who are escorting non John Carroll students must submit for approval the name, school, and parent's phone number for that student at lease one week prior to the event.
