# **HELPFUL HINT:**

## **EXAM SCHEDULES AND DETAILS:**

#### First Set: 15 Hours

Can be completed during or after Freshman year. Due no later than September 1st of Sophomore year.

Second Set: 30 Additional Hours/45 Total

Must be completed and approved by September 1st of Junior year.

Third Set: 30 Additional Hours/75 Total

Must be completed and approved by September 1st of senior year.

#### INFORMATION FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS:

Students who transfer after the end of their freshman year must only complete 30 hours before junior year and 30 more before senior year. Students who transfer after the end of sophomore year must only complete 30 total hours before senior year. Hours can be transferred from a previous school pending verification.




